Agency Referrals:

- ⇒ If you are referring a family, please contact staff first by calling (717) 737-1100 or e-mailing fphcrdirector@gmail.com to ask about openings and program requirements.
- ⇒ If you have worked with us previously, ask your client to fill out the application and mail, e-mail, or fax it. *Please call first.*

Self Referrals:

- ⇒ If you are in need of services, please call (717) 737-1100 or e-mail fphcrdirector@gmail.com.
- ⇒ You will be asked some initial questions about your family and then be sent an application.

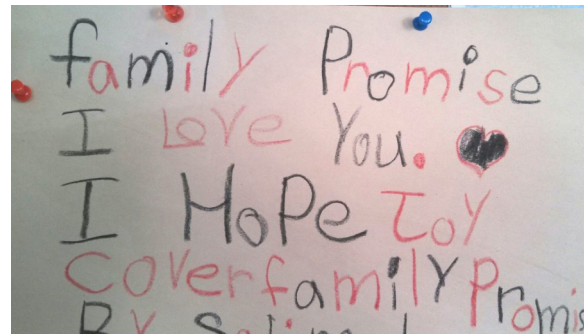
Eligibility Requirements

- ◆ Family (with children in high school or younger) or pregnant
- ◆ ANY family member included as long as they follow criteria—significant other, grandmother, etc.
- ◆ Drug & alcohol clean at least 30 days
- ◆ If experiencing a domestic violence situation, the family must leave at least 30 days prior to program entry
- ◆ At least one adult must be employable or currently employed
- ◆ Must be able to pass background check (no violent felonies, continuous history of charges, or abuse of children)

Looking For a Place to Call Home...

Services Provided

- ◆ Overnight lodging in local congregations (private space for your family)
- ◆ Three meals/day
- ◆ Shower and laundry facilities
- ◆ Computer access to work on goals
- ◆ Case management to assist with resources and goal-setting
- ◆ Assistance with finance planning, parenting, life, and communication skills
- ◆ Helping hands and caring hearts to support and build up your family



Other Programs

- ◆ Transitional housing for graduates
- ◆ After care case management
- ◆ Partnership with United Way and Family Support providing community classes two Saturdays/month with various topics located at First Christian Church. See website for more information and topics.

Application Process

- ◆ Call (717) 737-1100 and talk with staff about your situation. They will go through a quick form with you.
- ◆ Staff will either mail, e-mail, or fax you an application.
- ◆ Complete and return application.
- ◆ Staff will call you to set up an interview. The interview is about 30 minutes—1 hour. Staff will also share program requirements at that time and provide some hand-outs
- ◆ Staff will complete a background check for all adults.
- ◆ Staff will call within 48-hours of your interview to let you know if you are accepted.
